EXTENSION OF THE SECRETARIAT PRO TEMPORE

BEARING IN MIND Resolution CIT-COP6-2013-R3 that asked the United States of America continue hosting the *Pro Tempore* Secretariat until a headquarters agreement is agreed and implemented and extend the contract of the current *Pro Tempore* Secretary for an additional two years;

NOTING that the Working Group on the Legal Framework of the Convention and Permanent Secretariat has been working with interested Parties in the process to establish a Permanent Secretariat as requested in Resolution CIT-COP6-2013-R3;

TAKING IN TO ACCOUNT we are in the process of negotiating a hosting arrangement for the establishment of a Permanent Secretariat;

CONSIDERING that the Government of the United States of America has offered to renew the arrangement for the *Pro Tempore* Secretariat to continue to operate in the United States of America;

RECOGNIZING the need to provide the appropriate means for the functioning of the *Pro Tempore* Secretariat, as well as the quality of the work of the current Secretary;

CONSIDERING that this is an important matter that requires a decision to be adopted between sessions using Rule 5.5 of the Rules of Procedures for the Meetings of the Parties to the Inter-American Convention for the Protection and Conservation of Sea Turtles Resolution CIT-COP1-2003-R4-Rev.1.

THE CONFERENCE OF PARTIES OF THE INTER-AMERICAN CONVENTION FOR THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF SEA TURTLES

RESOLVE:

- 1. To request that the United States of America continue hosting the *Pro Tempore* Secretariat until a headquarters arrangement is agreed and implemented, and extend the contract of the current *Pro Tempore* Secretary until December 31st 2017 or until COP8 as decided by the Parties.
- 2. Request the Working Group on the Legal Framework of the Convention and Permanent Secretariat to continue its functions to assist IAC Parties for the establishment of a Permanent Secretariat.
